30	54-07-04. Salary of governor. The annual salary of the governor is eighty-five		
31	thousand five hundred six dollars through June 30, 2002, and eighty-seven eighty-eight		

- 1 thousand two nine hundred sixteen twenty-six dollars through June 30, 2006, and ninety-two 2 thousand four hundred eighty-three dollars thereafter.
- 3 **SECTION 6. AMENDMENT.** Section 54-08-03 of the North Dakota Century Code is 4 amended and reenacted as follows:
- 5 **54-08-03.** Salary of lieutenant governor. The annual salary of the lieutenant 6 governor is sixty-six thousand three hundred eighty dollars through June 30, 2002, and 7
- sixty-seven sixty-nine thousand seven hundred eight thirty-five dollars through June 30, 2006,
- 8 and seventy-one thousand seven hundred ninety-seven dollars thereafter.
