- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the public service
- 2 commission; to provide an appropriation for a rail rate complaint case; to amend and reenact
- 3 section 49-01-05 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the salary of public service
- 4 commissioners; and to declare an emergency.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

6 SECTION 1. BASE LEVEL FUNDING INFORMATION. The amounts identified in this
7 section represent the base level funding component appropriated to the public service

8 commission in section 3 of this Act as follows:

6 **SECTION 3.** APPROPRIATION. The funds provided in this section, or so much of the 7 funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state 8 treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and 9 other income, to the public service commission for the purpose of defraying the expenses of 10 that agency, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, and ending June 30, 2007, as follows: 11 Salaries and wages \$5,099,584 12 Operating expenses 1,408,153 13 Capital assets 58,511 14 Grants 7,000 3,668,492 15 Abandoned mined lands contractual services 900,000 16 Rail rate complaint case 17 Total all funds \$11,141,740 18 Less estimated income 5,985,139 19 \$5,156,601 Total general fund appropriation

SECTION 4. RAIL RATE COMPLAINT CASE. The general fund appropriation in
 section 3 of this Act includes the sum of \$900,000 to pay for the costs associated with the rail
 rate complaint case.

23 SECTION 5. AMENDMENT. Section 49-01-05 of the North Dakota Century Code is
 24 amended and reenacted as follows:

49-01-05. Salary of commissioners. The annual salary of a commissioner is sixty-six thousand five hundred nine dollars through December 31, 2001, sixty-eight seventy-two thousand five six hundred four sixty-nine dollars through June 30, 2002 2006, and sixty-nine may not exceed seventy-five thousand eight five hundred seventy four seventy-six dollars thereafter. All fees received or charged by any commissioner for any act or service rendered in any official capacity must be accounted for and paid over by the commissioner monthly to the state treasurer and must be credited to the general fund of the state.
