- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the public service
- 2 commission; to provide an appropriation for a rail rate complaint case; to amend and reenact
- 3 section 49-01-05 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the salary of public service
- 4 commissioners; to provide for a legislative council study; to provide an exemption to section
- 5 54-44.1-11 relating to unexpended appropriations; to provide legislative intent; and to declare
- 6 an emergency.

10	funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state				
11	treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and				
12	other income, to the public service commission for the purpose of defraying the expenses of				
13	that agency, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, and ending June 30, 2007, as follows:

23	SECTION 4. ESTIMATED INCOME - RAIL RATE COMPLAIN	T CASE. The estimated			
24	income line item appropriation in section 3 of this Act includes the sum of \$945,000, or so much				
25	of the sum as may be necessary, consisting of \$800,000 from the beginning farmer revolving				
26	loan fund, \$20,000 of carryover authority from the state rail fund, and \$125,000 from other				
27	sources, including the shipper participating in the case, to pay for the costs associated with the				
28	rail rate complaint case. The commission must have written commitments for \$125,000 from				
29	other sources, including the shipper participating in the case, before spending any moneys from				

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1 SECTION 5. AMENDMENT. Section 49-01-05 of the North Dakota Century Code is 2 amended and reenacted as follows: 3 **49-01-05.** Salary of commissioners. The annual salary of a commissioner is sixty six 4 thousand five hundred nine dollars through December 31, 2001, sixty-eight seventy-one 5 thousand five nine hundred four seventy dollars through June 30, 2002 2006, and sixty nine 6 seventy-four thousand eight hundred seventy-four forty-nine dollars thereafter. All fees 7 received or charged by any commissioner for any act or service rendered in any official 8 capacity must be accounted for and paid over by the commissioner monthly to the state 9 treasurer and must be credited to the general fund of the state. 10 **SECTION 6. EXEMPTION.** The amount appropriated for the rail rate complaint case, 11 as contained in section 1 of chapter 29 of the 2003 Session Laws, is not subject to the 12 provision of section 54-44.1-11. Any unexpended funds from the rail rate complaint case line 13 item are available for continued use for expenditures relating to the rail rate complaint case. 14 SECTION 7. LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL STUDY - PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION **DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES.** The legislative council shall consider studying, during the 15 16 2005-06 interim, the changes in responsibilities and duties of the public service commission 17 since its inception. The study should include an evaluation of what additional duties have been 18 given to the commission and those duties no longer performed. The legislative council shall 19 report its findings and recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement 20 the recommendations, to the sixtieth legislative assembly. 21 SECTION 8. REPAYMENT OF FUNDING. The public service commission shall 22 reimburse the beginning farmer revolving loan fund for any amounts available from damages or 23 proceeds received net of legal fees from a successful outcome of the rail rate complaint case. 24 SECTION 9. NORTH DAKOTA RAIL SYSTEM - LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the 25 intent of the legislative assembly that a well-maintained, efficient, and fairly priced railroad 26 transportation system in North Dakota is critical to the future of the North Dakota agriculture 27 sector and the use of funds from the beginning farmer revolving loan fund for the rail rate 28 complaint case will assist in achieving that objective. 29 SECTION 10. COMMISSION HEARING ROOM - LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the

intent of the legislative assembly that the public service commission hearing room be available

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- 1 for use by other state agencies and by the legislative assembly during the regular session when
- 2 not being used for commission business.
- 3 **SECTION 11. EMERGENCY.** The rail rate complaint case line item in section 3 of this
- 4 Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
