8	agency, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, and ending June 30, 2007, as follows:

13	SECTION 4. INSURANCE PREMIUMS TAX COLLECTIONS PAYMENTS TO FIRE

15	Act includes the sum of \$5,304,000, or so much of the sum as may be necessary to the	
16	insurance commissioner, of which \$5,200,000 is for the purpose of making payments of	
17	insurance premiums tax collections to fire departments and \$104,000 is for the purpose of	
18	making two equal payments to the North Dakota firefighter's association for the biennium	
19	beginning July 1, 2005, and ending June 30, 2007.

21	much of the sum as may be necessary, from the state bonding fund to pa	y bonding fund

28	sum of \$35,000, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, from the st	ate unsatisfied
29	judgment fund to pay unsatisfied judgment fund administrative expenses	for the biennium
30	beginning July 1, 2005, and ending June 30, 2007.	

1	SECTION 8. PETROLEUM TANK RELEASE COMPENSATION FUND. Section 3 of
2	this Act includes the sum of \$120,000, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, from the
3	petroleum tank release compensation fund to pay petroleum tank release compensation fund
4	administrative expenses for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, and ending June 30, 2007.
5	SECTION 9. ANHYDROUS AMMONIA STORAGE FACILITY INSPECTION FUND.
6	Section 3 of this Act includes the sum of \$150,000, or so much of the sum as may be
7	necessary, from the anhydrous ammonia storage facility inspection fund to pay for anhydrous
8	ammonia tank inspection costs for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, and ending June 30,
9	2007.
10	SECTION 10. AMENDMENT. Section 26.1-01-09 of the North Dakota Century Code is
11	amended and reenacted as follows:
12	26.1-01-09. Salary of commissioner. The annual salary of the commissioner is
13	sixty-four thousand seven hundred forty-two dollars through December 31, 2001, sixty-six
14	seventy thousand six seven hundred eighty-four thirty-nine dollars through June 30, 2002
15	2006, and sixty-eight may not exceed seventy-three thousand eighteen five hundred sixty-eight
16	dollars thereafter.
