- 4 the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the commissioner's salary.

6	SECTION 1. BASE LEVEL FUNDING INFORMATION. The	e amounts identified in this
7	section represent the base level funding component appropriated to the insurance	
8	commissioner in section 3 of this Act as follows:

6	funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state	
7	treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and	
8	other income, to the insurance commissioner for the purpose of defraying the expenses of that	
9	agency, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, and ending June 30, 2007, as follows:

14	SECTION 4. INSURANCE PREMIUMS TAX COLLECTIONS PAYME	ENTS. Section 3
15	of this Act includes the sum of \$7,420,000, or so much of the sum as may be	necessary to the
16	insurance commissioner, of which \$7,200,000 is for the purpose of making pa	yments of
17	insurance premiums tax collections to fire departments, \$120,000 is for the pu	rpose of making
18	two equal payments to the North Dakota firefighter's association, and \$100,00	0 is for the
19	purpose of providing a grant to the North Dakota association of oil and gas pro	oducing counties
20	for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, and ending June 30, 2007.	
21	SECTION 5. BONDING FUND. Section 3 this Act includes the sum of	f \$35,000, or so
22	much of the sum as may be necessary, from the state bonding fund to pay bo	nding fund
23	administrative expenses for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, and ending	June 30, 2007.
24	SECTION 6. FIRE AND TORNADO FUND. Section 3 of this Act inclu	ides the sum of
25	\$988,576, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, from the state fire and	d tornado fund to
26	pay fire and tornado fund administrative expenses for the biennium beginning	July 1, 2005, and
27	ending June 30, 2007.	
28	SECTION 7. UNSATISFIED JUDGMENT FUND. Section 3 of this A	ct includes the
29	sum of \$35,000, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, from the state u	unsatisfied
30	udgment fund to pay unsatisfied judgment fund administrative expenses for the biennium	
31	beginning July 1, 2005, and ending June 30, 2007.	

1	SECTION 8. PETROLEUM TANK RELEASE COMPENSATION FUND. Section 3 of
2	this Act includes the sum of \$120,000, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, from the
3	petroleum tank release compensation fund to pay petroleum tank release compensation fund
4	administrative expenses for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, and ending June 30, 2007.
5	SECTION 9. ANHYDROUS AMMONIA STORAGE FACILITY INSPECTION FUND.
6	Section 3 of this Act includes the sum of \$150,000, or so much of the sum as may be
7	necessary, from the anhydrous ammonia storage facility inspection fund to pay for anhydrous
8	ammonia tank inspection costs for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, and ending June 30,
9	2007.
10	SECTION 10. AMENDMENT. Section 26.1-01-09 of the North Dakota Century Code is
11	amended and reenacted as follows:
12	26.1-01-09. Salary of commissioner. The annual salary of the commissioner is
13	sixty four thousand seven hundred forty-two dollars through December 31, 2001, sixty-six
14	seventy thousand six hundred eighty four fifty-nine dollars through June 30, 2002 2006, and
15	sixty-eight seventy-two thousand eighteen eight hundred sixty-one dollars thereafter.
