1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 28 of chapter 167 of the 2005 Session Laws,
2 relating to the use of contingent state aid payments to purchase and distribute automated
3 external defibrillators to schools; and to declare an emergency.

4 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

5 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 28 of chapter 167 of the 2005 Session Laws is
6 amended and reenacted as follows:

7 **SECTION 28. CONTINGENCY.** If any moneys appropriated for per student payments
8 and transportation payments in the grants - state school aid line item in House Bill No. 1013, as
9 approved by the fifty-ninth legislative assembly, remain after payment of all statutory obligations
10 for per student and transportation payments during the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, and
11 ending June 30, 2007, and after the superintendent of public instruction has fulfilled any
12 directives contained in section 27 of this Act, the superintendent shall distribute the remaining
13 moneys as follows:

- 14 1. The superintendent of public instruction shall use the first \$450,000, or so much of
15 that amount as may be necessary, to provide additional payments to school
16 districts serving English language learners in accordance with section 15.1-27-12.
- 17 2. The superintendent of public instruction shall use the next \$1,000,000, or so much
18 of that amount as may be necessary, for the purpose of providing additional per
19 student payments to school districts participating in eligible educational
20 associations in accordance with section 32 of this Act.
- 21 3. The superintendent of public instruction shall use the next \$400,000, or so much of
22 that amount as may be necessary, to purchase automated external defibrillators
23 and place one in each public school in the state.

1 4. The superintendent of public instruction shall use the remainder of the moneys to
2 provide additional per student payments on a prorated basis according to the latest
3 available average daily membership of each school district.

4 **SECTION 2. EMERGENCY.** This Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
