1 A BILL for an Act relating to a legislative council study of grain inspection and grading  
2 procedures.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL STUDY - GRAIN INSPECTION**

5 **PROCEDURES.** The legislative council shall consider studying, during the 2007-08 interim,  
6 grain inspection and grading procedures, including the methodology, accuracy, uniformity, and  
7 cost-effectiveness of testing and sampling procedures and training and education standards  
8 that would be desirable in improving current procedures. The study should include the  
9 participation of agencies of the United States department of agriculture, industry groups, and  
10 North Dakota state university. The council shall report its findings and recommendations,  
11 together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to the sixty-first  
12 legislative assembly.
