

HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 3062

Introduced by

1 A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Council to study solutions to the problem of
2 underage drinking.

3 **WHEREAS**, the number of minors who reported using alcohol in the past month in
4 North Dakota was 42.7 percent according to the National Survey on Drug Use and Health
5 Report for 2003-04; and

6 **WHEREAS**, according to the same report, the number of minors in Tennessee who
7 reported using alcohol in the last month was 22.3 percent; and

8 **WHEREAS**, Tennessee has the lowest underage use of alcohol and North Dakota has
9 the highest underage use of alcohol; and

10 **WHEREAS**, Tennessee has serious consequences for minor in possession, including
11 the loss of the minor's license to operate a motor vehicle for at least 90 days, even if the minor
12 was not operating a vehicle at the time of the offense;

13 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES**
14 **OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:**

15 That the Legislative Council study solutions to the problem of underage drinking; and

16 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Legislative Council report its findings and
17 recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to
18 the Sixty-first Legislative Assembly.
