- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 12.1-34 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to the cost of forensic medical examinations for victims of sexual
- 3 assault; and to provide an appropriation.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 12.1-34 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:

Forensic medical examinations costs - Reimbursement by attorney general - Use of evidence.

- 1. When a forensic medical examination is performed on a victim of criminal sexual conduct for the purpose of gathering evidence of an alleged crime, the costs incurred by a health care facility or health care professional for performing the examination may not be charged, either directly or through a third-party payer, to the victim.
- 2. Upon submission of appropriate documentation, the attorney general, within the limits of legislative appropriations, shall reimburse the health care facility or a health care professional for the reasonable costs incurred in performing an examination.
- 3. Evidence obtained during a forensic medical examination may not be used against a victim for the prosecution of the victim for a separate offense.

SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION. There is appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$500,000, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, to the attorney general for the purpose of reimbursing health care facilities and health care professionals for the costs of performing forensic medical

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- 1 examinations on victims of criminal sexual conduct, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007,
- 2 and ending June 30, 2009.
