- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 50-29-05 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to eligibility under the state children's health insurance program.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

**SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 50-29-05 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

## 50-29-05. Limitations of chapter - Expansion of chapter.

- 1. Health assistance provided under this chapter is not an entitlement. A person does not have a property interest in any health assistance sought or provided under this chapter. If the department estimates that available funds are insufficient to allow participation by additional applicants, the department may take any action appropriate to avoid commitment of funds in excess of available funds, including denying applications and establishing waiting lists, that which is not forbidden by title XXI of the federal Social Security Act [42 U.S.C. 1397aa et seq.] or regulations adopted thereunder. If federal children's health insurance program funding decreases, the department may decrease the income eligibility limit to accommodate the decrease in federal funding, notwithstanding any other provisions of this chapter.
- 2. Notwithstanding any other provision of this chapter, if sufficient additional federal children's health insurance program funding becomes available, the department shall implement an income eligibility limit based on a gross income that does not exceed two hundred percent of the poverty line.
