- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 23-01 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to a state department of health viral hepatitis education and vaccination
- 3 program; to provide for surveillance and a report to the legislative council; and to provide an
- 4 appropriation.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

6 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 23-01 of the North Dakota Century Code is 7 created and enacted as follows:

8	Vira	Il hepatitis program - Vaccination - Study.
9	<u>1.</u>	The state department of health shall establish and administer a viral hepatitis
10		program with the goal of distributing to residents of the state who are at an
11		increased risk for exposure to viral hepatitis information that addresses the higher
12		incidence of hepatitis C exposure and infection among these populations,
13		addresses the dangers presented by the disease, and provides contacts for
14		additional information and referrals.
15	<u>2.</u>	The department shall establish a list of classes of individuals by category that are
16		at increased risk for viral hepatitis exposure. The list must be consistent with
17		recommendations developed by the federal centers for disease control. The
18		department shall determine the type of information the department will distribute
19		under the program and the form and manner of distribution.
20	<u>3.</u>	The department shall establish a vaccination and testing program, to be
21		coordinated by the department through local public health units.
22	22 SECTION 2. Viral hepatitis study and report. During the 2007-08 interim, the	
23	<u>department</u>	shall conduct surveillance to provide an epidemiological profile of hepatitis C and to
24	assess the current and future impact of viral hepatitis on the state. Before August 1, 2008, the	

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- 1 department shall submit to the legislative council a report regarding the results of the
- 2 surveillance, including a status report regarding the development and distribution of viral
- 3 <u>hepatitis information and the results of the vaccination and testing program.</u>

SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION. There is appropriated out of any moneys in the
general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$301,403, or so much
of the sum as may be necessary, to the state department of health for the purpose of
establishing a viral hepatitis program under section 1 of this Act, for the biennium beginning
July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2009. The state department of health is authorized one
full-time equivalent position for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2009.
