- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 36-01 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to the state board of animal health; to provide an appropriation; and to
- 3 declare an emergency.

## 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 5 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 36-01 of the North Dakota Century Code is 6 created and enacted as follows:
- 7 **Duties Animal tracking.** The board shall develop and maintain an animal tracking
- 8 data base to assist with tracking animal movements for animal health purposes only. The
- 9 information obtained and maintained in the data base is subject to open records laws as
- 10 provided for in section 36-09-28.
- 11 **SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION.** There is appropriated out of any moneys in the
- 12 general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$114,000, or so much
- 13 of the sum as may be necessary, to the state board of animal health for the development and
- 14 maintenance of an animal tracking data base, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, and
- 15 ending June 30, 2009.
- 16 **SECTION 3. EMERGENCY.** This Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
