- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 36-01 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to the state board of animal health; to provide an appropriation; and to
- 3 declare an emergency.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 36-01 of the North Dakota Century Code is 6 created and enacted as follows:

7 Duties - Animal tracking. The board shall develop and maintain an animal tracking

8 data base to assist with tracking animal movements for animal health purposes only. The

9 information obtained and maintained in the data base is subject to open records laws as

10 provided for in section 36-09-28.

SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION. There is appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$90,836, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, to the state board of animal health for the development and maintenance of an animal tracking data base, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2009.

16 **SECTION 3. EMERGENCY.** This Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
