TRANSFERS.** Notwithstanding section 54-16-04, the director of the office 26 of management and budget and the state treasurer shall make transfers of funds between line 27 items of appropriations for the legislative council as may be requested by the chairman of the 28 council or the chairman's designee upon the finding by the chairman or designee that the 29 nature of studies and duties assigned to the council requires the transfers in properly carrying 30 on the council's functions and duties. The director of the office of management and budget and

the state treasurer shall similarly make transfers of funds between the line items for the sixtieth

1 and sixty-first legislative assemblies, upon request by the chairman of the legislative council or 2 the chairman's designee upon the finding by the chairman or designee that the transfers are 3 required for the legislative assembly to carry on its functions and duties. 4 SECTION 5. ESTIMATED INCOME - INSURANCE REGULATORY TRUST FUND. 5 The estimated income line item in subdivision 2 of section 3 of this Act includes \$60,000 from 6 the insurance regulatory trust fund. 7 SECTION 6. ONE-TIME FUNDING - EFFECT ON BASE BUDGET - REPORT TO 8 SIXTY-FIRST LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY. The total general fund appropriation line item in 9 subdivision 1 of section 3 of this Act includes \$4,210,827 for the one-time funding items 10 identified in this section. This amount is not a part of the agency's base budget to be used in 11 preparing the 2009-11 executive budget. This amount is not a part of the agency's base budget to be used in preparing 22 the 2009-11 executive budget. COMMITTEE ROOM RENOVATION FUNDING - EXPENDITURE 29 **DETERMINATION.** Any expenditure of funds relating to \$100,000 of the \$200,000 provided for 30 committee room renovations in subdivision 1 of section 3 of this Act must be approved by a 31 majority of the senate members of the legislative management committee. Any expenditures

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- 1 relating to the remaining \$100,000 for committee room renovations must be approved by a
- 2 majority of the house of representatives members of the legislative management committee for
- 3 the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2009.
- 4 **SECTION 9. EMERGENCY.** This Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
