- 2 commission; and to create and enact a new section to chapter 2-05 of the North Dakota
- 3 Century Code, relating to creation of a rural airport economic development fund.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5	SECTION 1. BASE LEVEL FUNDING INFORMATION. T	he amounts identified in this
6	section represent the base level funding component appropriated to the aeronautics	
7	commission in section 3 of this Act as follows:

The funds provided in this section, or so much of the 4 funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state 5 treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and 6 other income, to the aeronautics commission for the purpose of defraying the expenses of that 7 agency, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2009, as follows: 8 Salaries and wages \$803.540 9 1,960,304 Operating expenses 10 Capital assets 734,000 11 Grants 3,575,000 12 Total all funds \$7,072,844 13 Less estimated income 6,522,844 14 \$550,000 Total general fund appropriation 15 **SECTION 4. TRANSFER.** During the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, and ending 16 June 30, 2009, the director of the office of management and budget shall transfer \$900,000 17 from the general fund to the rural airport economic development fund. 18 **SECTION 5.** APPROPRIATION. There is appropriated out of any moneys in the rural 19 airport economic development fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum 20 of \$900,000, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, to the aeronautics commission for 21 the purpose of the rural airport economic development fund, for the biennium beginning July 1, 22 2007, and ending June 30, 2009. 23 **SECTION 6.** A new section to chapter 2-05 of the North Dakota Century Code is 24 created and enacted as follows: 25 Rural airport economic development fund. 26 The rural airport economic development fund is a special fund in the state treasury. <u>1.</u> 27 Any earnings of the fund must be deposited in the fund. Subject to legislative 28 appropriation, the aeronautics commission may provide grants from the fund to a 29 public airport owned or operated by a public entity or to an airport operated by an 30 airport authority in this state for the purpose of providing financial assistance for:

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1 Purchase, development, and operation of automated weather reporting a. 2 facilities, computers and terminals to obtain weather information relating to 3 flight plans, and other equipment to enhance flight operational safety. 4 Obstruction removal within the runway protection zone of an airport to b. 5 facilitate the new global positioning satellite all-weather instrument approach 6 technology required to meet federal standards. 7 Construction or rehabilitation of runways, taxiways, and apron areas, <u>C.</u> 8 including the extension of runways that do not meet the federal guidelines for 9 this construction or rehabilitation but have a demonstrated state or local need. 10 Development of airport infrastructure and buildings that do not meet federal <u>d.</u> 11 guidelines for this development but have a demonstrated state or local need. 12 <u>2.</u> To qualify for a grant under this section, an airport must provide matching funds of not less than ten percent and not more than fifty percent. The aeronautics 13 14 commission shall set the match requirement in accordance with guidelines 15 established by the commission.
