4SECTION 1. BASE LEVEL FUNDING INFORMATION. The amounts identified in this5section represent the base level funding component appropriated to the state fair association in6section 3 of this Act as follows:7Capital assets\$210,0008Premiums<u>405,000</u>9Total general fund - Base level\$615,000

## 10 SECTION 2. FUNDING ADJUSTMENTS OR ENHANCEMENTS INFORMATION. The

11 amounts identified in this section represent the funding adjustments or enhancements to the

12 base funding level for the state fair association which are included in the appropriation in

13 section 3 of this Act as follows:

17 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION FOR THE STATE FAIR ASSOCIATION. The funds 18 provided in this section, or so much of the funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of 19 any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from 20 other income of the state fair association to the state fair association for the purpose of

- 21 defraying the expenses of the state fair association, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007,
- 22 and ending June 30, 2009, as follows:
