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SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION. The funds provided in this section, or so much of the
funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state
treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and
other income, to the state board for career and technical education for the purpose of defraying
the expenses of the various divisions, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, and ending
June 30, 2009, as follows:

SECTION 4. GRANTS - AREA CAREER AND TECHNOLOGY CENTERS.

- 1. The state board for career and technical education shall use \$1,200,000 of the grants line item in section 3 of this Act, for the development, during the second year of the biennium, of at least two new area career and technology centers in areas of the state that currently are not served. The board shall award the grants on a competitive basis and shall require a twenty-five percent match by a recipient. In awarding the grants, the board shall give consideration to the number of students who will be served and to alignments of the proposed area career and technology centers with existing educational associations governed by joint powers agreements.
- 2. The board shall use \$800,000 of the grants line item in section 3 of this Act, to increase cost-share incentives for area career and technology centers. The board shall also reallocate \$500,000 of the grants line item available for cost-share
