14	funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state			
15	treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and			
16	other income, to the North Dakota state university extension service, the northern crops			
17	institute, the upper great plains transportation institute, the main research center, branch			
18	research centers, and agronomy seed farm for the purpose of defraying the expenses of those			
19	agencies, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2009, as follows:

31	included in the grand total special funds appropriation line item in sec	ction 3 of this Act, any

- 1 other income, including funds from federal acts, private grants, gifts, and donations, or from
- 2 other sources received by the North Dakota state university extension service, the northern
- 3 crops institute, the upper great plains transportation institute, the main research center, branch
- 4 research centers, and agronomy seed farm, except as otherwise provided by law, is
- 5 appropriated for the purpose designated in the act, grant, gift, or donation, for the biennium
- 6 beginning July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2009.
- 7 **SECTION 5. TRANSFER AUTHORITY.** Upon approval of the state board of
- 8 agricultural research and education and appropriate branch research center directors, the
- 9 director of the main research center may transfer appropriation authority within subdivisions 1,
- 10 2, 4, and 5 of section 3 of this Act and shall notify the office of management and budget within
- 11 ten days following the transfer.
- 12 SECTION 6. FULL-TIME EQUIVALENT POSITION ADJUSTMENTS. The board of
- 13 higher education is authorized to adjust or increase full-time equivalent positions as needed for
- 14 the entities in section 3 of this Act, subject to availability of funds. The board shall report any
- 15 adjustments to the office of management and budget prior to the submission of the 2009-11
- 16 budget request.
- 17 SECTION 7. UNEXPENDED GENERAL FUND EXCESS INCOME. Any unexpended
- 18 general fund appropriation authority to and any excess income received by entities listed in
- 19 section 3 of this Act are not subject to the provisions of section 54-44.1-11, and any
- 20 unexpended funds from these appropriations or revenues are available and may be expended
- 21 by those entities, during the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, and ending June 30, 2011.
- 22 **SECTION 8. EMERGENCY.** The appropriation for capital projects of \$5,500,000 in
- 23 subdivision 3 of section 3, \$10,107,750 in subdivision 4 of section 3, and \$1,101,000 in
- 24 subdivision 5 of section 3 of this Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
