(At the request of the Governor)

- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the extension
- 2 service, northern crops institute, upper great plains transportation institute, main research
- 3 center, branch research centers, and agronomy seed farm; to amend and reenact section
- 4 24-02-03.3 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the central motor pool; to provide for
- 5 transfer of funds; to provide for a study; to authorize hemp seed procurement; to provide an
- 6 exemption; and to declare an emergency.

## 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

8	SECTION 1. BASE LEVEL FUNDING INFORMATION.	The amounts identified in this

16	funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state	
17	treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and	
18	other income, to the North Dakota state university extension service, the northern crops	
19	institute, the upper great plains transportation institute, the main research center, branch	
20	research centers, and agronomy seed farm for the purpose of defraying the expenses of those

ADDITIONAL INCOME - APPROPRIATION.** In addition to the amount 4 included in the grand total special funds appropriation line item in section 3 of this Act, any 5 other income, including funds from federal acts, private grants, gifts, and donations, or from 6 other sources received by the North Dakota state university extension service, the northern 7 crops institute, the upper great plains transportation institute, the main research center, branch 8 research centers, and agronomy seed farm, except as otherwise provided by law, is 9 appropriated for the purpose designated in the act, grant, gift, or donation, for the biennium 10 beginning July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2009. 11 **SECTION 5. TRANSFER AUTHORITY.** Upon approval of the state board of 12 agricultural research and education and appropriate branch research center directors, the 13 director of the main research center may transfer appropriation authority within subdivisions 1, 14 2, 4, and 5 of section 3 of this Act and shall notify the office of management and budget within 15 ten days following the transfer. 16 SECTION 6. FULL-TIME EQUIVALENT POSITION ADJUSTMENTS. The board of 17 higher education is authorized to adjust or increase full-time equivalent positions as needed for 18 the entities in section 3 of this Act, subject to availability of funds. The board shall report any 19 adjustments to the office of management and budget prior to the submission of the 2009-11 20 budget request. 21 **SECTION 7. AMENDMENT.** Section 24-02-03.3 of the North Dakota Century Code is 22 amended and reenacted as follows: 23 24-02-03.3. Central management system for all state-owned licensed motor 24 vehicles. 25 1. The director shall establish within the department a central vehicle management 26 system to regulate the operation, maintenance, and management of all motor 27 vehicles owned or leased by the state subject to registration under chapters 39-04 and 39-05. Upon the request of a state agency and an agreement between the 28 29 agency and director for the use of the motor vehicle-related equipment, the director 30 may purchase or lease motor vehicle-related equipment and include that 31 equipment within the system. The director shall provide a uniform method of

- documenting the use and cost of operation of motor vehicles and motor vehicle-related equipment in the system. The director shall advise the director of the office of management and budget as to the need to acquire or dispose of system motor vehicles. The specifications for highway patrol vehicles to be acquired may be set by the highway patrol superintendent. Every state agency, institution, department, board, bureau, and commission unless exempted by the director must use the system. At the request of the director of the North Dakota agricultural experiment station, certain vehicles used in farming operations at the agronomy seed farm and branch research centers shall be exempt from the requirements of this section. However, an agency, institution, department, board, bureau, or commission may authorize the use of an employee's personal motor vehicle pursuant to subsection 4 of section 54-06-09.
- 2. The director may enter into an agreement with a state employee who has a disability requiring a specially-equipped vehicle to pay a mileage rate greater than the rate established in section 54-06-09 for the employee's use of the employee's specially-equipped motor vehicle while conducting state business. The rate must be based on the rate provided in section 54-06-09, increased by the actual cost per mile caused by the special equipment, and may not exceed the cost associated with the special equipment expressed as the new value plus the depreciated fair market value in eight years divided by two, divided by twenty thousand miles.
- 3. Each entity required to use the system shall submit records of the operation of each vehicle as directed by the director.

**SECTION 8. UNEXPENDED GENERAL FUND - EXCESS INCOME.** Any unexpended general fund appropriation authority to and any excess income received by entities listed in section 3 of this Act are not subject to the provisions of section 54-44.1-11, and any unexpended funds from these appropriations or revenues are available and may be expended by those entities, during the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, and ending June 30, 2011.

**SECTION 9. INDUSTRIAL HEMP PRODUCTION - STUDY.** The main research center shall study industrial hemp production in North Dakota, including the latest available research and data regarding soils and growing conditions, seed availability, harvest methods, market

1 economies, environmental benefit, law enforcement concerns, and issues of concern to 2 producers from other countries. The agricultural experiment station shall present a report to the 3 legislative council by August 1, 2008. 4 **SECTION 10. HEMP SEED - PROCUREMENT - AUTHORIZATION.** The main 5 research center may contract with other entities for the procurement of hemp seed and to 6 conduct industrial hemp research. 7 **SECTION 11. EXEMPTION.** The amounts appropriated for the research greenhouse 8 complex project, as contained in subdivision 4 of section 3 of chapter 48 of the 2005 Session 9 Laws and for the north central research center laboratory and greenhouse project, as contained 10 in subdivision 5 of section 3 of chapter 48 of the 2005 Session Laws are not subject to the 11 provisions of section 54-44.1-11, and any unexpended funds from these appropriations or 12 related revenues are available and may be expended during the biennium beginning July 1, 13 2007, and ending June 30, 2009. The main research center may use any funding available 14 within the total appropriation authority for the main research center greenhouse project to begin 15 construction of the greenhouses. 16 SECTION 12. ONE-TIME FUNDING - EFFECT ON BASE BUDGET - REPORT TO 17 SIXTY-FIRST LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY. The total appropriation in section 3 of this Act 18 includes \$9,032,750 from the general fund and \$750,000 from the permanent oil tax trust fund 19 for the one-time funding items identified in this section. This amount is not a part of the 20 agency's base budget to be used in preparing the 2009-11 executive budget.
