- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the information
- 2 technology department; and to create and enact a new section to chapter 54-59 of the North
- 3 Dakota Century Code, relating to borrowing authority of the information technology department.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5	SECTION 1. BASE LEVEL FUNDING INFORMATION. Th	e amounts identified in this
6	section represent the base level funding component appropriated to	the information technology
7	department in section 3 of this Act as follows:

13	SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION. The funds provided in this section, or so much of the		
14	funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state		
15	treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and		
16	other income, to the information technology department for the purpose of defraying the		
17	expenses of that agency, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2009,		
18	as follows:

1	SECTION 4. TRANSFERS. Notwithstanding section 54-16-04, the director of the office
2	of management and budget shall make transfers of funds between line items in section 3 of this
3	Act for the information technology department as may be requested by the chief information
4	officer as determined necessary for the development and implementation of information
5	technology projects.
6	SECTION 5. A new section to chapter 54-59 of the North Dakota Century Code is
7	created and enacted as follows:
8	Borrowing authority - E-rate funding - Emergency commission approval.
9	Notwithstanding the limitations provided in section 54-59-05 and upon the approval of the
10	emergency commission, the department may borrow from the Bank of North Dakota an amount
11	necessary to pay telecommunications costs for connecting approved schools and libraries in
12	the event e-rate funding is not received by the department from the schools and libraries
13	division of the universal service administrative company. In addition to the principal repayment,
14	the Bank of North Dakota is entitled to receive interest on the loan at a rate equal to other state
15	agency borrowings. If at the end of the biennium a balance exists on any loan obtained
16	pursuant to this section and funds are not anticipated to be available from the schools and
17	libraries division of the universal service administrative company to repay the loan, the
18	department shall request a deficiency appropriation from the legislative assembly to repay to
19	<u>loan.</u>
