- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the committee on
- 2 protection and advocacy; and to provide legislative intent.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. BASE LEVEL FUNDING INFORMATION. The amounts identified in this section represent the base level funding component appropriated to the committee on protection and advocacy in section 3 of this Act as follows:

7 Total all funds - Base level \$3,720,979

8 Less estimated income - Base level 2,908,886

9 Total general fund - Base level \$812,093

10 SECTION 2. FUNDING ADJUSTMENTS OR ENHANCEMENTS INFORMATION. The

amounts identified in this section represent the funding adjustments or enhancements to the

12 base funding level for the committee on protection and advocacy which are included in the

13 appropriation in section 3 of this Act as follows:

14 Total all funds - Adjustments/enhancements \$232,821

15 Less estimated income - Adjustments/enhancements 182,449

16 Total general fund - Adjustments/enhancements \$50,372

17 **SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION.** The funds provided in this section, or so much of the

18 funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state

19 treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and

20 other income, to the committee on protection and advocacy for the purpose of defraying the

21 expenses of that agency, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2009,

22 as follows:

1 Total all funds \$3,953,800 2 Less estimated income 3,091,335 Total general fund appropriation 3 \$862,465 4 **SECTION 4. LEGISLATIVE INTENT - FEDERALLY FUNDED DISABILITIES** ADVOCATE. It is the intent of the sixtieth legislative assembly that if federal funds are not 5 6 available for the new disabilities advocate position provided for in this Act, the position will not 7 be filled and will be eliminated in the agency's 2009-11 budget request.
