1	A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new subsection to section 43-28.1-03 and a new		
2	section to chapter 43-28.1 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to selection and eligibility		
3	for loan repa	ayment under the dentists' loan repayment program; and to provide legislative	
4	intent.		
5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:		
6	SECTION 1. A new subsection to section 43-28.1-03 of the North Dakota Century		
7	Code is created and enacted as follows:		
8		For the purposes of a dentist selected for loan payment who practices within fifteen	
9		miles [24.14 kilometers] of the city limits of Bismarck, Fargo, or Grand Forks, to	
10		qualify to receive a yearly disbursement under this chapter during that year of	
11		obligated service, the dentist must have received dental medical payments of at	
12		least twenty thousand dollars in the form of medical assistance reimbursement.	
13	SEC	CTION 2. A new section to chapter 43-28.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is	
14	created and enacted as follows:		
15	New practices - Grants.		
16	<u>1.</u>	A dentist who graduated from an accredited dental school within the previous five	
17		years and is licensed to practice in North Dakota may submit an application to the	
18		state health council for a grant for the purpose of establishing a dental practice in a	
19		city in the state which has a population that does not exceed seven thousand five	
20		hundred.	
21	<u>2.</u>	The state health council may award a maximum of two grants per year and shall	
22		establish the criteria for the grant program under subsection 1 which must include:	

A maximum grant award of fifty thousand dollars per applicant;

A requirement that the community must provide a fifty percent match for a

1	<u>C.</u>	A requirement that a dentist who receives a grant under this section must use	
2		the funds for buildings, equipment, and operating expenses;	
3	<u>d.</u>	A provision that the grant must be distributed in equal amounts over a	
4		five-year period; and	
5	<u>e.</u>	A requirement that a dentist selected for a grant under this section must	
6		commit to practice in the community for a minimum of five years.	
7	SECTIO	N 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT - GRANT PREFERENCE. House Bill No. 1004	
8	contains a \$380,	000 appropriation from the community health trust fund to the state department	
9	of health for the dental loan repayment program for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, and		
10	ending June 30,	2009. This funding is also to be used for the grant program established in this	
11	Act, with prefere	nce in the use of the funding to the grant applicants.
