1	A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new subsection to section 43-28.1-03 and a new					
2	section to chapter 43-28.1 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to selection and eligibility					
3	for loan repayment under the dentists' loan repayment program and for new practice grants; to					
4	provide for a legislative council study; and to provide an appropriation.					
5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:					
6	SECTION 1. A new subsection to section 43-28.1-03 of the North Dakota Century					
7	Code is created and enacted as follows:					
8		For the purposes of a dentist selected for loan payment who practices within fifteen				
9	miles [24.14 kilometers] of the city limits of Bismarck, Fargo, or Grand Forks, to					
10	qualify to receive a yearly disbursement under this chapter during that year of					
11		<u>obli</u>	gated service, the dentist must have:			
12		<u>a.</u>	Received dental medical payments of at least twenty thousand dollars in the			
13			form of medical assistance reimbursement; or			
14		<u>b.</u>	Practiced at least two full workdays per week at a public health clinic or at a			
15			nonprofit dental clinic that uses a sliding fee schedule to bill the nonprofit			
16			dental clinic's patients.			
17	SEC	СТІО	N 2. A new section to chapter 43-28.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is			
18	created and enacted as follows:					
19	New practices - Grants.					
20	<u>1.</u>	<u>A d</u>	entist who graduated from an accredited dental school within the previous five			
21		yea	rs and is licensed to practice in North Dakota may submit an application to the			
22		stat	te health council for a grant for the purpose of establishing a dental practice in a			
23		city	in the state which has a population that does not exceed seven thousand five			
24		hun	ndred.			

1	<u>2.</u>	The state health council may award a maximum of two grants per year and shall			
2		establish the criteria for the grant program under subsection 1 which must include			
3		<u>a.</u>	A maximum grant award of fifty thousand dollars per applicant;		
4		<u>b.</u>	A requirement that the community must provide a fifty percent match for a		
5			grant;		
6		<u>C.</u>	A requirement that a dentist who receives a grant under this section must use		
7			the funds for buildings, equipment, and operating expenses;		
8		<u>d.</u>	A provision that the grant must be distributed in equal amounts over a		
9			five-year period; and		
10		<u>e.</u>	A requirement that a dentist selected for a grant under this section must		
11			commit to practice in the community for a minimum of five years.		
12	SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL STUDY - COMMUNITY HEALTH TRUST				
13	FUND. The	e legis	slative council shall consider studying, during the 2007-08 interim, the historic		
14	and anticipated uses of funds from the community health trust fund, including a cost-benefit				
15	evaluation of past expenditures from the fund, the feasibility and desirability of establishing a				
16	strategic plan for future use of the fund, and the sustainability of the fund. The legislative				
17	council shall report its findings and recommendations, together with any legislation required to				
18	implement t	he re	ecommendations, to the sixty-first legislative assembly.		
19	SEC	OIT	N 4. APPROPRIATION. There is appropriated out of any moneys in the		
20	community	healt	h trust fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of		
21	\$60,000, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, to the state department of health for the				
22	purpose of funding the new practice grant program, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007,				
23	and ending June 30, 2009
