5 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsection 1 of section 43-15-01 of the North Dakota 6 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows: 7 "Administration" means the direct application of a drug to the body of a patient. 8 The term includes: a. The emergency maintenance of a drug delivery device used in home 9 (1) 10 infusion therapy by a qualified home pharmacist when nursing service 11 is not available: 12 (2) Upon an order by a physician or nurse practitioner authorized to 13 prescribe such a drug or by written protocol with a physician or nurse 14 practitioner: 15 (a) Immunization and vaccination by injection of an individual who is 16 more than eighteen eleven years of age, upon an order by a 17 physician or nurse practitioner authorized to prescribe such a 18 drug or by written protocol with a physician or nurse practitioner; 19 and 20 Influenza vaccination by injection of an individual who is more (b) 21 than five years of age; and 22 (3)Provision of drugs by subcutaneous, intradermal, and intramuscular 23 injection to an individual who is more than eighteen years of age upon

the order of a physician or nurse practitioner authorized to prescribe
such a drug.

b. The term does not include the regular ongoing delivery of a drug to the patient in a health care setting and other parenteral administration of a drug.
