1d.An award grant under this section is not a business incentive under chapter254-60.1.

SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION. There is appropriated out of any moneys in the
general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$500,000, or so much
of the sum as may be necessary, to the North Dakota development fund for the purpose of
making technology award grants as provided for under Section 1 of this Act, for the biennium
beginning July 1, 2011, and ending June 30, 2013.
