## 8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 9 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 17-03-01 of the North Dakota Century Code is
  10 amended and reenacted as follows:
- 17-03-01. Definitions. In this chapter, unless the context or subject matter otherwise
  requires:
- "Biodiesel production facility" means a producer of a biodegradable, combustible
   liquid fuel that is derived from vegetable oil or animal fat and which is suitable for
- 15 blending with diesel fuel for use in internal combustion diesel engines <u>fuel</u>
- 16 composed of mono-alkyl esters of long chain fatty acids derived from vegetable oil
- 17 or animal fats that meets American society for testing and materials specification
- 18 <u>D 6751</u>. The facility must be located in this state and:
- 19a.Agricultural producers must hold at least ten percent of the ownership interest20in the facility; or
- b. Residents of this state must own at least fifty percent of the ownership interestof the facility.

  24 fund established to buy down the interest rate on loans to biodiesel and, ethanol,

AMENDMENT. Section 19-10-01 of the North Dakota Century Code is 28 amended and reenacted as follows: 29 19-10-01. Definitions. In this chapter, unless the context or subject matter otherwise 30 requires:

1 1. "Adulterated", when used to describe any petroleum or alternative fuel product, 2 denotes a petroleum or alternative fuel product which fails to meet the 3 specifications prescribed by this chapter. 4 2. "Alternative fuel" means a fuel for an engine or vehicle, or used as heating oil, 5 other than a petroleum-based fuel. The term includes biodiesel and green diesel 6 as defined in section 57-43.2-01. 7 "Biodiesel" means any non-petroleum-based diesel fuel made from renewable 3. 8 resources such as vegetable oils or animal fats. 9 "Department" means the state department of health. 4. 10 "Diesel fuel" is any petroleum product intended for use or offered for sale as a fuel <del>5.</del> <u>4.</u> 11 for engines in which the fuel is injected into the combustion chamber and ignited by 12 pressure without electric spark. 13 "Gasoline" is a refined petroleum naphtha which by its composition is suitable for <del>6.</del> <u>5.</u> 14 use as a carburant in internal combustion engines. "Heating oil" is any product intended for use or offered for sale as a furnace oil, 15 <del>7.</del> 6. 16 range oil, or fuel oil for heating and cooking purposes to be used in burners other 17 than wick burners regardless of whether the product is designated as furnace oil, 18 range oil, fuel oil, gas oil, or is given any other name or designation. 19 "Kerosene" is a petroleum fraction which is free from water, additives, foreign or <del>8.</del> 7. 20 suspended matter, and is suitable for use as an illuminating oil. 21 <del>9.</del> <u>8.</u> "Lubricating oil" is any petroleum, or other product, used for the purpose of 22 reducing friction, heat, or wear in automobiles, tractors, gasoline engines, diesel 23 engines, and other machines. 24 <del>10.</del> <u>9.</u> "Misbranded", when used in connection with any petroleum or alternative fuel 25 product, denotes a petroleum or alternative fuel product which is not labeled as 26 required under the provisions of this chapter. 27 <del>11.</del> 10. "Sell" and "sale" include the keeping, offering, or exposing for sale, transportation, 28 or exchange of the restricted or prohibited article. 29 <del>12.</del> 11. "Tractor fuel" is any product, other than gasoline or kerosene, intended for use or 30 offered for sale as a fuel for tractors, regardless of whether the product is 31 designated as distillate, gas oil, fuel oil, or is given any other name or designation.

1	SECTION 6. AMENDMENT. Section 54	17.7-02 of the North Dakota Century Code is

- 3 54-17.7-02. Definitions. As used in this chapter: 4 1. "Authority" means the industrial commission acting as the North Dakota pipeline 5 authority. 6 2. "Commission" means the North Dakota industrial commission. 7 3. "Energy-related commodities" means any substance, element, or compound, either 8 gaseous, liquid, or solid, associated with the production, refining, or processing of 9 renewable energy, crude oil, natural gas, coal, or coal byproducts, including oil, 10 natural gas liquids, refined petroleum products, carbon dioxide, hydrogen, ethanol, 11 propane, butane, ethane, methane, sulfur, helium, synthetic fuels, nitrogen, 12 biodiesel, green diesel, and liquids made from coal. 13 4. "Natural gas" means hydrocarbons or nonhydrocarbons that at atmospheric 14 conditions of temperature and pressure are in a gaseous phase. 15 5. "Notice of intent" means the notice a person delivers to the authority indicating 16 willingness to construct pipeline facilities contemplated by the authority or to 17 provide services fulfilling the need for such pipeline facilities. 18 6. "Pipeline facilities" means pipelines, pumps, compressors, storage, and all other
- facilities, structures, and properties incidental and necessary or useful in the
  interconnection of pipelines or the transportation, distribution, and delivery of
  energy-related commodities to points of sale or consumption or to the point or
  points of distribution for consumption located within and without this state.
- 23 7. "Project area" means the geographic area in which construction of a pipeline
  24 facility contemplated by the authority is likely to occur.

SECTION 7. AMENDMENT. Section 54-44.5-09 of the North Dakota Century Code is
 amended and reenacted as follows:

54-44.5-09. Office of renewable energy and energy efficiency. The office of
renewable energy and energy efficiency is established within the division of community
services. The office shall assist in the development of renewable energy within this state to
provide secure, diverse, sustainable, and competitive renewable energy supplies and promote
the conservation of energy and the wise use of energy resources in both the public and private

1 sectors. The office shall communicate and disseminate information concerning state and 2 federal energy conservation and renewable energy incentives, including tax credits, financing, 3 and grants to business entities seeking to invest in wind-generated power and transmission, 4 ethanol production and distribution; and the development of biodiesel, green diesel, biomass, 5 solar, hydropower, geothermal, and other renewable energy sources. The office also shall also 6 manage and distribute all production incentive payments as authorized by chapter 17-02. 7 SECTION 8. AMENDMENT. Section 57-38-01.22 of the North Dakota Century Code is 8 amended and reenacted as follows: 9 57-38-01.22. Income tax credit for blending of biodiesel fuel or green diesel fuel. 10 A fuel supplier licensed pursuant to section 57-43.2-05 who blends biodiesel fuel or green 11 diesel fuel is entitled to a credit against tax liability determined under section 57-38-30 or 12 57-38-30.3 in the amount of five cents per gallon [3.79 liters] of biodiesel fuel or green diesel

13 fuel of at least five percent blend, otherwise known as B5. For purposes of this section,

14 "biodiesel" means and "green diesel" mean fuel meeting the specifications adopted by the

15 American society for testing and materials as defined in section 57-43.2-01. The credit under

16 this section may not exceed the taxpayer's liability as determined under this chapter for the

17 taxable year and each year's unused credit amount may be carried forward for up to five

18 taxable years.

A partnership, subchapter S corporation, limited partnership, limited liability company, or any other passthrough entity entitled to the credit under this section must be considered to be the taxpayer for purposes of this section, and the amount of the credit allowed must be determined at the passthrough entity level. The amount of the total credit determined at the entity level must be passed through to the partners, shareholders, or members in proportion to their respective interests in the passthrough entity.

25 **SECTION 9. AMENDMENT.** Section 57-38-01.23 of the North Dakota Century Code is 26 amended and reenacted as follows:

27 **57-38-01.23.** Income tax credit for biodiesel <u>or green diesel</u> sales equipment

28 **costs.** A seller of biodiesel fuel <u>or green diesel fuel</u> is entitled to a credit against tax liability

determined under section 57-38-30 or 57-38-30.3 in the amount of ten percent per year for five

30 years of the biodiesel or green diesel fuel seller's direct costs incurred after December 31,

31 2004, to adapt or add equipment to a facility, licensed under section 57-43.2-05, to enable the

1 facility to sell diesel fuel containing at least two percent biodiesel fuel or green diesel fuel by 2 volume. For purposes of this section, "biodiesel fuel" means and "green diesel fuel" mean fuel 3 meeting the specifications adopted by the American society for testing and materials as defined 4 in section 57-43.2-01. The credit under this section may not exceed a taxpayer's liability as 5 determined under this chapter for the taxable year and each year's unused credit amount may 6 be carried forward for up to five taxable years. A biodiesel or green diesel fuel seller is limited 7 to fifty thousand dollars in the cumulative amount of credits under this section for all taxable 8 years. A biodiesel or green diesel fuel seller may not claim a credit under this section for any 9 taxable year before the taxable year in which the facility begins selling biodiesel or green diesel 10 fuel containing at least two percent biodiesel or green diesel fuel by volume, but eligible costs 11 incurred before the taxable year sales begin may be claimed for purposes of the credit under 12 this section for taxable years on or after the taxable year sales of biodiesel or green diesel fuel 13 begin. 14 A partnership, subchapter S corporation, limited partnership, limited liability company, or 15 any other passthrough entity entitled to the credit under this section must be considered to be 16 the taxpayer for purposes of this section, and the amount of the credit allowed must be 17 determined at the passthrough entity level. The amount of the total credit determined at the 18 entity level must be passed through to the partners, shareholders, or members in proportion to 19 their respective interests in the passthrough entity. 20 SECTION 10. AMENDMENT. 30	any taxable year before the taxable year in which the facility begins production or blending of					
31	diesel fuel cont	aining at least two percent biodiesel fuel or green diesel fuel by volume or				

1	begins crushing soybeans or canola, but eligible costs incurred before the taxable year					
2	production, blending, or crushing begins may be claimed for purposes of the credit under this

26		silvicultural products, and other renewable resources, which meets applicable				
27		American society for testing and materials specifications.				
28	SECTION 15. EFFECTIVE DATE. Section 13 of this Act is effective for taxable events					
29	after June 30, 2011.
