Introduced by

- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact sections 4-42-01, 4-42-02, 4-42-03, 4-42-04, 4-42-05,
- 2 4-42-06, 4-42-07, 4-42-08, 4-42-09, 4-42-10, and 4-42-11 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 3 relating to the inspection and analysis of seeds and crops for the purpose of verifying genetic
- 4 identity; and to provide a continuing appropriation.

5 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

6 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 4-42-01 of the North Dakota Century Code is

7 amended and reenacted as follows:

- 8 **4-42-01. Definitions.** As used in this chapter, unless the context otherwise requires:
- 9 1. "Analysis" means the laboratory examination of seeds, crops, or plant tissue to
- 10 determine the genetic identity or physical traits of the seeds or crops.
- 11 2. "Commission" means the state seed commission.
- 12 3. "Commissioner" means the state seed commissioner.
- 13 4. "Department" means the state seed department.
- 14 5. "Inspection" means a visual field inspection of seeds or crops.

NOTE: Because the individual sections in this chapter reference the Seed Commission, the Seed Commissioner, and the Seed Department, it is not necessary to include this terminology in a definition section.

15 SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Section 4-42-02 of the North Dakota Century Code is

16 amended and reenacted as follows:

17 4-42-02. Commissioner - Genetic identity - Physical traits - Analysis and

- 18 verification. The seed commissioner may establish procedures for inspecting, analyzing, and
- 19 verifying the genetic identity or physical traits of seeds or crops. The procedures may address
- 20 the compilation of all necessary documentation and other administrative functions.

NOTE: It is recommended that this section be repealed. The content of the first sentence is reiterated in Section 4-42-03. As for the second sentence, in order to

inspect, analyze, and verify the genetic identity or physical traits of the seed or crops, the Seed Commissioner will have to utilize certain protocols and procedures. It is not necessary to statutorily list suggestions for such. If the Seed Commissioner wishes to create a more formal system, the Seed Commissioner is able to adopt rules to implement the chapter.

1 SECTION 3. AMENDMENT. Section 4-42-03 of the North Dakota Century Code is

2 amended and reenacted as follows:

3 4-42-03. Inspection and analysis - Procurement of samples Samples -

- 4 <u>Specifications</u>.
- 5 <u>1.</u> The <u>seed</u> commissioner may inspect and analyze seed or crop grown¹, sold, or 6 otherwise <u>situated</u> <u>present</u> in this state to determine and verify the genetic identity 7 or physical traits of the seed or the crop. The
- 8 <u>2.</u> For purposes of conducting the inspection, analysis, or verification, the seed
 9 commissioner may procure:
- 10a.Obtain² samples of seed or crop grown in this state, sold in this state, or11otherwise situated in this state; or may accept for analysis and verification
- 12
 b.
 Accept samples submitted of seed or crop grown in this state, sold in this

 state, or otherwise situated in this state from any public or nonpublic entity
- 14 that is the owner of <u>owns</u> the seed or crop.
- 15 <u>3.</u> The <u>seed</u> commissioner shall determine <u>may specify</u> the size and nature of each
- 16 sample to be submitted to the laboratory tested under this chapter, the manner in
- 17 which each sample is to be taken, the purposes for which each sample is to be
- 18 taken, obtained and delivered to the seed commissioner, and the manner in which
- 19 each sample's identity is to be preserved, and the manner in which each sample is
- 20 to be delivered to the laboratory.

NOTE:

- ¹ Is it necessary to mention "plant tissues" as well?
- ² It is not clear if the intent of this section is to authorize the Seed Commissioner to enter upon private property for the purposes of obtaining a sample.

21 SECTION 4. AMENDMENT. Section 4-42-04 of the North Dakota Century Code is

22 amended and reenacted as follows:

4-42-04. Field inspections. The seed commissioner shall determine the criteria for
field inspections.

NOTE: In order to conduct a field inspection, the Seed Commissioner will have to utilize certain scientific protocols and procedures. It is not necessary to suggest that the Seed Commissioner do so. If the Seed Commissioner wishes to create a more formal system, the Seed Commissioner is able to adopt rules governing field inspections.

- 1 SECTION 5. AMENDMENT. Section 4-42-05 of the North Dakota Century Code is
- 2 amended and reenacted as follows:
- 3 4-42-05. Inspection and analysis Fee. The seed commissioner, with the approval of
- 4 the commission, shall establish and charge a fee, subject to the approval of the seed
- 5 <u>commission</u>, for inspecting, analyzing, and performing any other services permitted by <u>service</u>
- 6 <u>under</u> this chapter.

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7 SECTION 6. AMENDMENT. Section 4-42-06 of the North Dakota Century Code is
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- 8 amended and reenacted as follows:
- 9 4-42-06. Laboratories and facilities. The seed commissioner shall provide and
- 10 maintain may utilize any laboratories and or other facilities necessary to conduct the analyses
- 11 authorized by this chapter and to effect any other work necessary established by or under the
- 12 <u>control of the seed commission</u> to implement this chapter.

NOTE: The rewording of this section clarifies that the Seed Commissioner may use existing facilities to analyze and verify seeds, crops, and plant tissue in accordance with this chapter.

- 13 SECTION 7. AMENDMENT. Section 4-42-07 of the North Dakota Century Code is
- 14 amended and reenacted as follows:
- 15 **4-42-07. Identity preservation Traceability.** The <u>seed</u> commissioner may establish
- 16 a procedure for the identity preservation and traceability of seeds or crops inspected or
- 17 analyzed under this chapter.

NOTE:

- Do you wish to authorize the Seed Commissioner to establish a procedure for identity preservation and traceability or do you wish to require that the Seed Commissioner utilize such a procedure in certain instances?
- ² Should the reference to "verification" be included as well?
- 18 SECTION 8. AMENDMENT. Section 4-42-08 of the North Dakota Century Code is
- 19 amended and reenacted as follows:
- 20 **4-42-08.** Labels Documentation. The <u>seed</u> commissioner shall prescribe the type
- 21 of labels and <u>any</u> other identifying documentation to be affixed by the commissioner to
- 22 <u>necessary to identify</u> seeds or crops inspected and analyzed¹ under this chapter. All labels and
- 23 other identifying documentation affixed used by the seed commissioner in accordance with this

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- 1 chapter must clearly bear the identification of the department and may be used only by the
- 2 commissioner in conjunction with the verification services provided under this chapter include
- 3 the departmental seal².

NOTE:

- ¹ Should the reference to "verification" be included as well?
- ² The departmental seal is the official identification of the Seed Department. Is use of the seal that which is intended?
- 4 **SECTION 9. AMENDMENT.** Section 4-42-09 of the North Dakota Century Code is
- 5 amended and reenacted as follows:

6 **4-42-09. Contract for services - Protection of growers.** The <u>seed</u> commissioner

- 7 may contract with any public or private entity to provide person for the protection, inspection,
- 8 analysis, or verification of seeds or crops, as provided by this chapter.

NOTE: Should "plant tissue" be referenced as well? It is included in the current definition of "analysis" as found in Section 4-42-01. Is "verification" an act that is sufficiently separate from the definition of "analysis"?

9 SECTION 10. AMENDMENT. Section 4-42-10 of the North Dakota Century Code is

10 amended and reenacted as follows:

11 4-42-10. Deposit of fees - Investment Receipt of moneys - Seed department fund -

12 **Continuing appropriation**.

- 13 <u>1.</u> The <u>seed</u> commissioner shall deposit forward all moneys arising from the
- 14 collection of fees received under this chapter with to the state treasurer for credit to
- 15 <u>deposit in a special fund known as</u> the seed department revolving fund. At the
- 16 direction of the commission, the state treasurer shall provide for the investment of
- 17 available moneys from the revolving fund. The state treasurer shall deposit twenty
- 18 percent of the income from the investment of the moneys in the general fund and
- 19 the remaining eighty percent of the investment income in the seed department
- 20 revolving fund¹All moneys in the seed department fund are appropriated on a
- 21 <u>continuing basis to the seed department to carry out statutory directives.</u>
- 22 <u>2.</u> The seed commissioner shall approve all expenditures made pursuant to this
- 23 <u>chapter and shall document the expenditures at the time and in the manner</u>
 24 required by the office of management and budget.

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- ¹ The language governing the investment of moneys in the Seed Department fund has been omitted because it was addressed in the rewrite of the chapter pertaining to the Seed Department and seed labeling laws.
- 1 SECTION 11. AMENDMENT. Section 4-42-11 of the North Dakota Century Code is
- 2 amended and reenacted as follows:
- 3 4-42-11. Warranties or representations regarding seeds or crops. The seed
- 4 commission, the seed commissioner, and the seed department make no warranties or
- 5 representations of any kind, either expressed or implied, including warranties of merchantability,
- 6 fitness for a particular purpose, or absence of disease, as to seed or crop that is inspected,
- 7 analyzed, or verified under this chapter.
