- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation to the state department of health for providing
- 2 emergency medical training grants to rural law enforcement and individuals choosing to
- 3 become licensed first responders.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 5 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** There is appropriated out of any moneys in the
- 6 general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$128,400, or so much
- 7 of the sum as may be necessary, to the state department of health for the purpose of providing
- 8 emergency medical training grants to rural law enforcement and individuals choosing to
- 9 become licensed first responders, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, and ending June 30,
- 10 2011. For the purposes of this section, rural law enforcement means licensed officers from city
- 11 police departments of cities with a population under 6,500 and all licensed officers from county
- 12 sheriffs' offices.
