SENATE BILL NO. 2159 (Senators Lyson, Robinson, Flakoll, Nelson) (Representative Delmore)

AN ACT to amend and reenact subsection 2 of section 27-20-14 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the detention of a child participating in a juvenile drug court program.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsection 2 of section 27-20-14 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

If a child is participating in a juvenile drug court program <u>as a result of an adjudication for a delinquent offense</u>, the drug court may order the child detained <u>in a juvenile detention center operated pursuant to chapter 12-44.1</u>. The child may be detained twice during the child's participation in the program but the total period of detention under this subsection may not exceed four days in a one-year period.
