HOUSE BILL NO. 1217 (Representatives Kerzman, Froelich, Hanson, Porter) (Senators Krauter, Lyson, Wanzek)

AN ACT to amend and reenact section 20.1-01-22 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to hunting on lands having unharvested oilseed crops; and to provide a penalty.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 20.1-01-22 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

20.1-01-22. Hunting game on lands having unharvested crops unlawful. It is unlawful to hunt or pursue game in unharvested cereal <u>or oilseed</u> crops without permission of the owner or tenant. Such <u>Cereal</u> crops include alfalfa, clover, and other grasses grown for seed. <u>Oilseed crops include</u> sunflower, safflower, rapeseed or canola, crambe, soybeans, and flax.
