HOUSE BILL NO. 1244 (Representatives Ruby, Bellew, Gruchalla, Kasper) (Senators Dever, Hogue)

AN ACT to amend and reenact section 12.1-11-07 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to defrauding a urine test.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 12.1-11-07 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

12.1-11-07. Fraudulent practice in urine testing. A person is guilty of a class A misdemeanor if that person willfully defrauds a urine test and the test is designed to detect the presence of a chemical substance or a controlled substance. <u>A person is guilty of a class A misdemeanor if that person knowingly possesses, distributes, or assists in the use of a device, chemical, or real or artificial urine advertised or intended to be used to alter the outcome of a urine test.</u>
