FIRST ENGROSSMENT with Conference Committee Amendments ENGROSSED SENATE BILL NO. 2001

1 A BILL for an Act providing an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the legislative branch 2 of state government; to provide for transfers; to create and enact a new subsection to section 3 54-03.1-03 and a new section to chapter 54-35 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to 4 the agenda of the organizational session and to a legislative budget committee: to amend and 5 reenact subdivision c of subsection 7 of section 54-03-20, section 54-44.1-04, subsection 7 of 6 section 54-44.1-06, and section 54-44.1-07 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to 7 legislative leaders' monthly compensation, budget requests, and drafts of appropriation bills; to 8 provide for applications and transfers; to provide for a legislative council study; to provide an 9 effective date; and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA: 10

11 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** The funds provided in this section, or so much of the 12 funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state 13 treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from the insurance 14 regulatory trust fund, not otherwise appropriated, to the legislative branch of state government 15 for the purpose of defraying the expenses of that branch, for the fiscal period beginning with the 16 effective date of this Act and ending June 30, 2011, as follows:

2011-13 biennium. The legislative assembly shall report to the appropriations committees of
the sixty-second legislative assembly on the use of this one-time funding for the biennium
beginning July 1, 2009, and ending June 30, 2011.

9 SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL ONE-TIME FUNDING - EFFECT ON BASE
10 BUDGET - REPORT TO SIXTY-SECOND LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY. The following amounts
11 reflect the one-time funding items approved by the sixtieth legislative assembly for the 2007-09
12 biennium and the 2009-11 one-time funding items included in the appropriation for the

13 legislative council in section 1 of this Act:

The 2009-11 one-time funding amounts are not a part of the entity's base budget for the 2011-13 biennium. The legislative council shall report to the appropriations committees of the 22 sixty-second legislative assembly on the use of this one-time funding for the biennium 23 beginning July 1, 2009, and ending June 30, 2011.

24 SECTION 4. TRANSFERS. Notwithstanding section 54-16-04, the director of the office 25 of management and budget and the state treasurer shall make transfers of funds between line 26 items of appropriations for the legislative council as may be requested by the chairman of the 27 council or the chairman's designee upon the finding by the chairman or designee that the 28 nature of studies and duties assigned to the council requires the transfers in properly carrying 29 on the council's functions and duties. The director of the office of management and budget and 30 the state treasurer shall similarly make transfers of funds between the line items for the 31 sixty-first and sixty-second legislative assemblies, upon request by the chairman of the

legislative council or the chairman's designee upon the finding by the chairman or designee that
 the transfers are required for the legislative assembly to carry on its functions and duties.

3 SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE WING EQUIPMENT AND IMPROVEMENT FUNDING -4 **EXPENDITURE DETERMINATION.** Any expenditure of funds relating to the sum of \$400,000 5 of the \$1,000,000 provided for legislative wing equipment and improvements in subdivision 1 of 6 section 1 of this Act must be approved by a majority of the senate members of the legislative 7 management committee, or its successor. Any expenditures relating to a separate sum of 8 \$400,000 of the \$1,000,000 for legislative wing equipment and improvements must be 9 approved by a majority of the house of representatives members of the legislative management 10 committee, or its successor, and any expenditures relating to the remaining \$200,000 must be 11 approved by a majority of all members of this committee, for the biennium beginning July 1, 12 2009, and ending June 30, 2011.

SECTION 6. APPLICATION AND TRANSFER AUTHORITY. North Dakota Century
 Code sections 54-16-04 and 54-44.1-11 do not apply to chapter 1 of the 2007 Session Laws.
 The director of the office of management and budget and the state treasurer shall make
 transfers of funds between the line items and the agencies of the legislative branch within
 section 1 of that chapter as requested by the chairman of the legislative council or the
 chairman's designee.

19 SECTION 7. LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL STUDY - STATE EMPLOYEE

COMPENSATION. During the 2009-10 interim, the legislative council shall consider studying the classified state employee compensation system, including a review of the development and determination of pay grades and classifications. The legislative council shall report its findings and recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to the sixty-second legislative assembly.

SECTION 8. ADDITIONAL LODGING REIMBURSEMENT FOR 2009 LEGISLATIVE
 ASSEMBLY. Notwithstanding the per calendar month lodging maximum provided in section
 54-03-20 for members of the legislative assembly during a legislative session, a member of the
 sixty-first legislative assembly is entitled to lodging reimbursement as provided in section
 44-08-04 for state officers and employees for each calendar day the sixty-first legislative
 assembly is in session during the month of April 2009 if the member submits a voucher
 indicating the actual amount expended for lodging during the month of April.

1	SECTION 9. AMENDMENT. Subdivision c of subsection 7 of section 54-03-20 of the		
2	North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:		
3	c. The majority and minority leaders of the house and senate and the chairman		
4	of the legislative council, if the chairman is not a majority or minority leader,		
5	are each entitled to receive as compensation, in addition to any other		
6	compensation or expense reimbursement provided by law, the sum of two		
7	hundred seventy eighty-four dollars per month during the biennium for their		
8	execution of public duties.		
9	SECTION 10. AMENDMENT. Subdivision c of subsection 7 of section 54-03-20 of the		
10	North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:		
11	c. The majority and minority leaders of the house and senate and the chairman		
12	of the legislative council, if the chairman is not a majority or minority leader,		
13	are each entitled to receive as compensation, in addition to any other		
14	compensation or expense reimbursement provided by law, the sum of two		
15	hundred seventy ninety-eight dollars per month during the biennium for their		
16	execution of public duties.		
17	SECTION 11. A new subsection to section 54-03.1-03 of the North Dakota Century		
18	Code is created and enacted as follows:		
19	Presentation of the report of the legislative budget committee as provided in		
20	section 12 of this Act;		
21	SECTION 12. A new section to chapter 54-35 of the North Dakota Century Code is		
22	created and enacted as follows:		
23	Legislative budget committee - Creation - Duties. The legislative council, during		
24	each biennium, shall appoint a legislative budget committee consisting of sixteen members,		
25	eight of whom must be appointed by the majority leader of the senate and eight of whom must		
26	be appointed by the majority leader of the house of representatives. The committee shall		
27	coordinate and direct activities involved in the development of budget recommendations to		
28	assist the legislative assembly as the legislative assembly develops policy and provides		
29	appropriations for the operations of state government. The legislative budget committee, with		
30	the assistance of the legislative budget analyst and auditor:

2		consider including in its forms and guidelines for agencies to use in preparing	
3		budget requests;	
4	<u>2.</u>	Shall review, analyze, and evaluate budgets, budget requests, programs, and	
5		activities of state agencies, institutions, and departments;	
6	<u>3.</u>	Shall prepare drafts of appropriations acts for the next biennium providing funding	
7		at the same base level approved by the most recently adjourned special or regular	
8		session of the legislative assembly;	
9	<u>4.</u>	May meet up to four times between November tenth of each even-numbered year	
10		and the organizational session of the legislative assembly to develop	
11		budget-related recommendations pertaining to the state budget or any portion of	
12		that budget, including revenues and appropriations to assist the legislative	
13		assembly as the legislative assembly develops policy and provides appropriations	
14		for the operations of state government. The committee may prepare draft	
15		amendments for consideration by the legislative assembly necessary to implement	
16		budget-related recommendations of the committee; and	
17	<u>5.</u>	Shall prepare a report for presentation on the first day of organizational session.	
18	SE	CTION 13. AMENDMENT. Section 54-44.1-04 of the North Dakota Century Code is	
19	amended a	nd reenacted as follows:	
20	(Eff	ective after June 30, 2009) Budget estimates of budget units filed with the	
21	office of th	he budget and the legislative council - Deadline. The head of each budget unit,	
22	not later that	an July fifteenth of each year next preceding the session of the legislative assembly,	
23	3 shall submit to the office of the budget and the legislative council, estimates of financial		
24	requirements of the person's budget unit for the next two fiscal years, on the forms and in the		
25	manner prescribed by the office of the budget considering recommendations of the legislative		
26	council, with such explanatory data as is required by the office of the budget and such		
27	additional data as the head of the budget unit wishes to submit. The estimates so submitted		
28	must bear the approval of the board or commission of each budget unit for which a board or		
29	commission is constituted. The director of the budget, subject to approval by the legislative		
30	council, may extend the filing date for any budget unit if the director finds there is some		
31	circumstan	ce that makes it advantageous to authorize the extension. If a budget unit has not	

Shall develop recommendations for the office of management and budget to

submitted its estimate of financial requirements by the required date or within a period of
extension set by the director of the budget, the director of the budget shall prepare the budget
unit's estimate of financial requirements except the estimate may not exceed ninety percent of
the budget unit's previous biennial appropriation. The director of the budget or a subordinate
officer as the director shall designate shall examine the estimates and shall afford to the heads
of budget units reasonable opportunity for explanation in regard thereto and, when requested,
shall grant to the heads of budget units a hearing thereon which must be open to the public.

8 SECTION 14. AMENDMENT. Subsection 7 of section 54-44.1-06 of the North Dakota
9 Century Code, as effective after June 30, 2009, is amended and reenacted as follows:

- 7. Drafts of a proposed <u>amendment to a</u> general appropriations act and special
 appropriations acts embodying the budget data and recommendations of the
 governor for appropriations for the next biennium and drafts of such revenues and
 other acts recommended by the governor for putting into effect the proposed
 financial plan. The recommended general appropriation for each budget unit must
 be specified in a separate section of the general appropriations act.
- SECTION 15. AMENDMENT. Section 54-44.1-07 of the North Dakota Century Code is
 amended and reenacted as follows:

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54-44.1-07. Presentation of budget data - How presented to the legislative

19 **assembly.** The director of the budget or the director's designee shall present the budget data 20 information in section 54-44.1-06, except the drafts of acts amendments required by 21 subsection 7 of that section, and make available sufficient copies thereof to the legislative 22 assembly at the organizational session. The drafts of acts amendments required by 23 subsection 7 of section 54-44.1-06 must be submitted to the legislative council within seven 24 days after the day of adjournment of the organizational session. The budget data must be 25 completed and made available to the legislative assembly in such form as may be prescribed 26 by the legislative council. The legislative council shall set the time and place at which such 27 budget data is to be presented.

28 SECTION 16. EFFECTIVE DATE. Section 9 of this Act becomes effective on July 1,
2009, and section 10 of this Act becomes effective on July 1, 2010.

30 **SECTION 17. EMERGENCY.** This Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
