- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the public service
- 2 commission; to provide legislative intent; to provide for a report to the budget section; and to
- 3 amend and reenact section 49-01-05 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the salary
- 4 of public service commissioners.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

**SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and other income, to the public service commission for the purpose of defraying the expenses of that agency, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, and ending June 30, 2011, as follows:

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## 1 SECTION 2. ONE-TIME FUNDING - EFFECT ON BASE BUDGET - REPORT TO 2 SIXTY-SECOND LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY. The following amounts reflect the one-time 3 funding items approved by the sixtieth legislative assembly for the 2007-09 biennium and the 4 2009-11 one-time funding items included in the appropriation in section 1 of this Act: 5 One-Time Funding Description 2007-09 2009-11 6 \$0 Videoconferencing equipment \$20,000 7 0 Weights and measures equipment 39.000 8 High-flow dispenser prover 30,484 0 9 Total general fund \$89,484 \$0 10 The 2009-11 one-time funding amounts are not a part of the entity's base budget for the 11 2011-13 biennium. The public service commission shall report to the appropriations 12 committees of the sixty-second legislative assembly on the use of this one-time funding for the 13 biennium beginning July 1, 2009, and ending June 30, 2011. 14 SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT - METROLOGY PROGRAM. It is the intent of 15 the legislative assembly that the public service commission continue to provide the metrology 16 program services at its current level and study location alternatives that do not include the 17 construction of a new facility for the sole purpose of housing the metrology program for the 18 biennium beginning July 1, 2009, and ending June 30, 2011. 19 SECTION 4. REPORT TO THE BUDGET SECTION. The public service commission 20 shall report to the budget section prior to July 1, 2010, regarding the status of location 21 alternatives for the metrology program. 22 **SECTION 5. AMENDMENT.** Section 49-01-05 of the North Dakota Century Code is 23 amended and reenacted as follows: 24 **49-01-05.** Salary of commissioners. The annual salary of a commissioner is 25 seventy eight eighty-five thousand five eight hundred ninety-nine thirty dollars through June 30, 26 2008 2010, and eighty one ninety thousand seven one hundred forty-three twenty-two dollars 27 thereafter. All fees received or charged by any commissioner for any act or service rendered in 28 any official capacity must be accounted for and paid over by the commissioner monthly to the

state treasurer and must be credited to the general fund of the state.
