1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the state department

2 of health; to provide legislative intent; and to amend and reenact subsections 5 and 6 of section

3 43-12.2-01 and subsection 3 of section 43-12.2-03 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating

4 to the medical loan repayment program.

5 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

6 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. The funds provided in this section, or so much of the 7 funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state 8 treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and 9 other income, to the state department of health for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the 10 state department of health, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, and ending June 30, 2011, 11 as follows:

14	environment and rangeland protection fund, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, and						
15	ending June 30, 2011. This amount includes \$50,000 for a grant to the North Dakota						
16	stockmen's association environmental services program.

30		loan repayment under this chapter:					

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1	a.	Must be a graduate of an accredited program, located in the United States or
2		Canada, for the preparation of nurse practitioners, physician assistants, or
3		certified nurse midwives;
4	b.	Must be enrolled in or have graduated from an accredited training program for
5		nurse practitioners, physician assistants, or certified nurse midwives prior to
6		or within one year after submitting an application to participate in the loan
7		repayment program and may not have practiced full time as a nurse
8		practitioner, physician assistant, or certified nurse midwife in this state within
9		three years for more than one year before the date of the application;
10	C.	Must be licensed or registered to practice as a nurse practitioner, physician
11		assistant, or certified nurse midwife in this state;
12	d.	Shall submit an application to participate in the loan repayment program; and
13	e.	Must have entered into an agreement with a selected community to provide
14		full-time services for a minimum of two years at the selected community if the
15		applicant receives a loan repayment program contract.
