4	SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds			
5	as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state			
6	treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from the insurance			
7	regulatory trust fund, not otherwise appropriated, to the legislative branch of state government			
8	for the purpose of defraying the expenses of that branch, for the fiscal period beginning with the			
9	effective date of this Act and ending June 30, 2013, as follows:

11 The 2011-13 one-time funding amounts are not a part of the entity's base budget for the

12 2013-15 biennium. The legislative management and legislative council shall report to the

13 appropriations committees of the sixty-third legislative assembly on the use of this one-time

funding for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, and ending June 30, 2013.

SECTION 4. TRANSFERS. Notwithstanding section 54-16-05, the director of the office of management and budget and the state treasurer shall make transfers of funds between line items of appropriations for the legislative management and legislative council as may be requested by the chairman of the legislative management or the chairman's designee upon the finding by the chairman or designee that the nature of studies and duties assigned to the legislative management or legislative council requires the transfers in properly carrying on the legislative management and legislative council's functions and duties. The director of the office of management and budget and the state treasurer shall similarly make transfers of funds between the line items for the sixty-second and sixty-third legislative assemblies, upon request by the chairman of the legislative management or the chairman's designee upon the finding by the chairman or designee that the transfers are required for the legislative assembly to carry on its functions and duties.

SECTION 5. APPLICATION AND TRANSFER AUTHORITY. Sections 54-16-04 and 54-44.1-11 do not apply to chapter 29 of the 2009 Session Laws. The director of the office of management and budget and the state treasurer shall make transfers of funds between the line items and the agencies of the legislative branch within section 1 of that chapter as requested by the chairman of the legislative management or the chairman's designee.
