4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 23-01.2 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:

The state health officer shall appoint an emergency medical services and trauma medical director to provide medical oversight and consultation in the development and administration of the state emergency medical services and trauma systems. The medical director must be a physician licensed in the state and must be contracted and paid by the state department of health.

SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION. The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the permanent oil tax trustgeneral fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, to the state department of health for the support of the comprehensive state trauma system, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, and ending June 30, 2013, as follows:
