3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4	SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION - COMMUNITY SERVICE SUPERVISION GRANTS -	
5	FUNDING ALLOCATION. There is appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the	
6	state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$375,000, or so much of the sum as may	
7	be necessary, to the office of management and budget for the purpose of providing community	
8	service supervision grants, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, and ending June 30, 2013.	
9	The office of management and budget shall distribute the grant funds on an annual basis on	
10	August first of each year of the 2011-13 biennium to North Dakota community corrections	
11	association regions as follows:
