- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation to the office of management and budget for
- 2 transfers to the veterans' postwar trust fund and the veterans' aid fund.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION - TRANSFER - VETERANS' POSTWAR TRUST FUND.

- 5 There is appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise
- 6 appropriated, the sum of \$400,000, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, which the
- 7 office of management and budget shall transfer to the veterans' postwar trust fund to provide
- 8 additional funding for programs authorized by law to benefit and serve veterans or their
- 9 dependents, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, and ending June 30, 2013.

10 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION - TRANSFER - VETERANS' POSTWAR TRUST FUND.

- 11 There is appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise
- 12 appropriated, the sum of \$2,000,000, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, which the
- 13 office of management and budget shall transfer to the veterans' postwar trust fund to increase
- 14 the principal balance of the fund to generate additional income for programs authorized by law
- 15 to benefit and serve veterans or their dependents, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, and
- 16 ending June 30, 2013.
- 17 **SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION TRANSFER VETERANS' AID FUND.** There is
- appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise
- appropriated, the sum of \$500,000, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, which the
- 20 office of management and budget shall transfer to the veterans' aid fund to increase the balance
- 21 available in the fund for programs authorized by law to benefit and serve veterans or their
- dependents, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, and ending June 30, 2013.
