## ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL NO. 1005

(At the request of the Governor)

1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the Indian affairs  
2 commission.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds  
5 as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state  
6 treasury, not otherwise appropriated, to the Indian affairs commission for the purpose of  
7 defraying the expenses of that agency, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, and ending  
8 June 30, 2013, as follows:

20 **SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT - SUICIDE PREVENTION PROGRAM.** It is the intent  
21 of the sixty-second legislative assembly that the Indian affairs commission work in conjunction  
22 with the state department of health to develop a suicide prevention program, including outreach,  
23 education, administration, and implementation of grants for suicide prevention activities for the  
24 biennium beginning July 1, 2011, and ending June 30, 2013.
