3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds

5 as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state

treasury, not otherwise appropriated, to the Indian affairs commission for the purpose of

defraying the expenses of that agency, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, and ending

SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT - SUICIDE PREVENTION PROGRAM. It is the intent of the sixty-second legislative assembly that the Indian affairs commission work in conjunction

with the state department of health to develop a suicide prevention program, including outreach,

education, administration, and implementation of grants for suicide prevention activities for the

biennium beginning July 1, 2011, and ending June 30, 2013.
