- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the office of the
- 2 governor; to amend and reenact sections 54-07-04 and 54-08-03 of the North Dakota Century
- 3 Code, relating to the salaries of the governor and lieutenant governor; and to declare an
- 4 emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and other income, to the office of the governor for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the office of the governor, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, and ending June 30, 2013, as follows:

- 13 2013-15 biennium. The governor's office shall report to the appropriations committees of the
- 14 sixty-third legislative assembly on the use of this one-time funding for the biennium beginning
- 15 July 1, 2011, and ending June 30, 2013.
- 16 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION GOVERNOR'S OFFICE. In addition to the amounts
- 17 appropriated to the governor's office in section 1 of this Act, there is appropriated any additional
- 18 income from federal or other funds which may become available to the agency for the biennium
- 19 beginning July 1, 2011, and ending June 30, 2013.
- 20 **SECTION 4. AMENDMENT.** Section 54-07-04 of the North Dakota Century Code is
- 21 amended and reenacted as follows:
- 22 **54-07-04.** Salary of governor.
- The annual salary of the governor is one hundred fivethirteen thousand and thirty-fourfive
- 24 <u>hundred ninety-four</u> dollars through June 30, 20102012, and one hundred tenseventeen
- 25 thousand two hundred eighty-fiveone dollars thereafter.
- **SECTION 5. AMENDMENT.** Section 54-08-03 of the North Dakota Century Code is
- 27 amended and reenacted as follows:
- 28 **54-08-03. Salary of lieutenant governor.**
- The annual salary of the lieutenant governor is <u>eighty-one_eighty-eight</u> thousand <u>five_one_eighty-eight</u>.
- 30 hundred thirty-eighteighty-three dollars through June 30, 20102012, and eighty-fiveninety
- 31 thousand sixeight hundred fifteentwenty-nine dollars thereafter.
