## SENATE BILL NO. 2010

1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the insurance

2 commissioner; to provide for making payments of insurance premiums tax collections to fire

3 departments; and to amend and reenact section 26.1-01-09 of the North Dakota Century Code,

4 relating to the commissioner's salary.

## 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

6 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds 7 as may be necessary, are appropriated from special funds derived from federal funds and other 8 income, to the the insurance commissioner for the purpose of defraying the expenses of that

9 agency, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, and ending June 30, 2013, as follows:

## 23 SECTION 3. INSURANCE PREMIUM TAX DISTRIBUTION FUND PAYMENTS - USES.

24 Section 1 of this Act includes \$6,820,000 from the insurance premium tax distribution fund, of

1 which \$6,200,000 is for the purpose of making payments to fire departments and \$620,000 is

2 for the purpose of making two equal payments to the North Dakota firefighter's association, for

3 the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, and ending June 30, 2013.

SECTION 4. BONDING FUND. Section 1 of this Act includes \$46,769 from the state
bonding fund to pay bonding fund administrative expenses for the biennium beginning July 1,

6 2011, and ending June 30, 2013.

7 SECTION 5. FIRE AND TORNADO FUND. Section 1 of this Act includes \$1,611,575 from

8 the state fire and tornado fund, including \$170,000 for a grant to the North Dakota firefighter's

9 association and \$1,441,575 to pay fire and tornado fund administrative expenses, for the

10 biennium beginning July 1, 2011, and ending June 30, 2013.

SECTION 6. UNSATISFIED JUDGMENT FUND. Section 1 of this Act includes \$27,349
 from the state unsatisfied judgment fund to pay unsatisfied judgment fund administrative

13 expenses for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, and ending June 30, 2013.

SECTION 7. PETROLEUM RELEASE COMPENSATION FUND. Section 1 of this Act
 includes \$46,769 from the petroleum release compensation fund to pay petroleum release
 compensation fund administrative expenses for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, and
 ending June 30, 2013.

SECTION 8. AMENDMENT. Section 26.1-01-09 of the North Dakota Century Code is
 amended and reenacted as follows:

20 **26.1-01-09**. Salary of commissioner.

21 The annual salary of the commissioner is eighty-threeninety thousand fivethree hundred

22 fiftysixty dollars through June 30, 20102012, and eighty-sevenninety-three thousand seven-

23 hundred twenty-eightseventy-one dollars thereafter.
