- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the state historical
- 2 society; and to amend and reenact section 4 of chapter 28 of the 2009 Session Laws, relating to
- 3 the project manager for the heritage center addition project.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and other income, to the state historical society for the purpose of defraying the expenses of that agency, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, and ending June 30, 2013, as follows:

SECTION 3. REVOLVING FUND - APPROPRIATION. All fees collected by the state historical society and deposited in the revolving fund established pursuant to section 55-03-04

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are appropriated to the state historical society for the purposes provided in chapter 55-03, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, and ending June 30, 2013.

SECTION 4. GIFTS, GRANTS, AND BEQUESTS - APPROPRIATION. All gifts, grants, devises, bequests, donations, and assignments received by the state historical society and deposited with the state treasurer pursuant to section 55-01-04 are appropriated to the state historical society for the purposes provided in section 55-01-04, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, and ending June 30, 2013.

SECTION 5. AMENDMENT. Section 4 of chapter 28 of the 2009 Session Laws is amended and reenacted as follows:

SECTION 4. PROJECT MANAGER - HERITAGE CENTER ADDITION

PROJECT. The director of the facility management division of the office of management and budget shall serve as the project construction manager for the heritage center addition project for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, and ending June 30, 2011throughout its completion. All expenditures relating to project construction and exhibits must be reviewed for approval by the project construction manager.
