SB 2202: A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact sections 57-39.2-04.5, 57-39.2-04.6, and 57-40.2-03.3 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the sales and use tax exemption for materials used in compressing, processing, gathering, or refining gas, the sales and use tax exemption for materials used in construction or expansion of an oil refinery, and the use tax on contractors; and to provide an effective date.

SB 2203: A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 54-27-26 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to annual reports for transportation funding.

Was read the first time and referred to the **Transportation Committee**.

Sens. Sitte, Christmann, Wanzek and Reps. Kasper, Schmidt, Wrangham introduced:

SB 2204: A BILL for an Act to prohibit state funding of the northern plains national heritage area.

Was read the first time and referred to the **Agriculture Committee**.

Sens. Nodland, Klein, Schneider and Reps. Gruchalla, Keiser, Vigesaa introduced:

SB 2205: A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subsections 4 and 6 section 65-01-16 and subsection 2 of section 65-04-32 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to attorney representation in a request for workforce safety and insurance reconsideration, who may appeal a decision of the decision review office, and service of an employer.

Was read the first time and referred to the Industry, Business and Labor Committee.

Sens. Miller, Olafson, Murphy and Reps. Belter, Boe, Schmidt introduced:

SB 2206: A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 49-02 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to anemometer towers; to provide a penalty; and to provide for application.

Was read the first time and referred to the Natural Resources Committee.

Sens. Lyson, Wardner and Reps. Kempenich, Rust introduced:

- **SB 2207:** A BILL for an Act to create and enact section 39-04-18.2 and a new subsection to section 57-40.3-04 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to temporary motor vehicle registration and excise tax; to amend and reenact subdivisions c and e of subsection 2 of section 39-04-18, subsection 2 of section 39-06.1-06, and section 39-06.1-08 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to motor vehicle registration; and to declare an emergency.
- Was read the first time and referred to the **Transportation Committee**.

Sens. Schaible, Cook, Marcellais and Reps. Rohr, Schmidt introduced:

- **SB 2208:** A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subdivision o of subsection 2 of section 57-38-30.3 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the income tax exemption applying to qualifying reservation residents, activities, and sources; and to provide an effective date.
- Was read the first time and referred to the Finance and Taxation Committee.

Sens. Klein, Nodland, Warner and Reps. Delmore, Keiser, Owens introduced:

- **SB 2209:** A BILL for an Act to create and enact two new sections to chapter 48-01.2 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to using the design-build procurement process for public improvement projects; and to amend and reenact section 48-01.2-01 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the definition of design-build.
- Was read the first time and referred to the Industry, Business and Labor Committee.

Sens. Wardner, Lyson, Krebsbach and Reps. Hawken, Keiser, Winrich introduced:

SB 2210: A BILL for an Act to create and enact two new sections to chapter 54-17 and a new subdivision to subsection 2 of section 54-60.1-01 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to an affordable housing fund; and to provide an appropriation.

Was read the first time and referred to the Appropriations Committee.

Sens. Grindberg, Wardner, Robinson and Reps. Hawken, Kreun, Mueller introduced:

SB 2211: A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subsection 5 of section 37-19.1-02 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to exemptions to veterans' preference and public employees.

Was read the first time and referred to the Government and Veterans Affairs Committee.

Sens. J. Lee, Uglem, Warner and Reps. Kilichowski, Weisz introduced:

SB 2212: A BILL for an Act to provide for a state department of health study of department programs for catastrophic diseases; to provide for a report to the legislative management; and to provide an appropriation.

Was read the first time and referred to the Human Services Committee.
