1 | A BILL for an Act to reimburse school districts and nonpublic schools for expenses incurred in
2 | providing cardiopulmonary resuscitation training to students; and to provide an appropriation.

3 | **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 | **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** There is appropriated out of any moneys in the general
5 | fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$450,000, or so much of the
6 | sum as may be necessary, to the superintendent of public instruction for the purpose of
7 | reimbursing school districts and nonpublic schools for costs incurred in providing
8 | cardiopulmonary resuscitation training to students, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2013, and
9 | ending June 30, 2015.

10 | 1. ~~In order to be eligible for a reimbursement under this section, a~~Each school district
11 | shall set aside one high school class period in a required course of the district's
12 | choosing, for the purpose of providing instruction in cardiopulmonary resuscitation to
13 | as many students as possible. Each nonpublic school shall set aside one high school
14 | class period in a required course of the school's choosing, for the purpose of providing
15 | instruction in cardiopulmonary resuscitation to as many students as possible. The

16 | training must:

- 17 | a. Conform to the most recent national evidence-based American heart association
18 | guidelines for cardiopulmonary resuscitation and emergency cardiovascular care;
19 | b. Be conducted according to guidelines established by the American heart
20 | association, the American red cross, or some other nationally recognized
21 | nonprofit organization;
22 | c. Include the practice of chest compressions; and
23 | d. Include instruction in the use of an automated external defibrillator.
