HOUSE BILL NO. 1434
(Representatives Schatz, Fehr, Heller, N. Johnson, Monson, Steiner, Thoreson)
(Senators Laffen, Poolman, Schneider)

AN ACT to amend and reenact subsection 6 of section 20.1-03-12 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to fishing license fees for the disabled.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsection 6 of section 20.1-03-12 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

6. For a resident fishing license, ten dollars, except that for a resident sixty-five years or over ~~or~~, a resident totally or permanently disabled, or a resident disabled veteran who has a fifty percent service-connected disability as determined by the department of veterans' affairs or has an extra-schedular rating to include individual unemployability that brings the veteran's total disability ratio to fifty percent, the license fee is ~~three~~five dollars.
