1 A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Management to study the feasibility and  
2 desirability of providing assistance to obtain rural water for households with arsenic and other  
3 harmful substances in the well water.

4 **WHEREAS**, water is essential for human life and production agriculture; and

5 **WHEREAS**, harmful substances in drinking water especially affect children; and

6 **WHEREAS**, there are wells that provide water to families in this state which have unsafe  
7 levels of arsenic in the present water supply; and

8 **WHEREAS**, the federal government has stopped funding to provide rural water to those  
9 households;

10 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF**  
11 **NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:**

12 That Legislative Management study the feasibility and desirability of providing assistance to  
13 obtain rural water for households with arsenic and other harmful substances in the well water;  
14 and

15 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Legislative Management report its findings and  
16 recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to  
17 the Sixty-fourth Legislative Assembly.
