- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 39-06.1-06 and subsection 2 of section
- 2 40-05-06 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to fees for speeding.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 39-06.1-06 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 6 **39-06.1-06. Amount of statutory fees.**
- The fees required for a noncriminal disposition pursuant to either section 39-06.1-02 or 39-06.1-03 must be as follows:
- 9 1. For a nonmoving violation as defined in section 39-06.1-08, a fee of any amount not to exceed twenty dollars.
- 11 2. For a moving violation as defined in section 39-06.1-09, a fee of twenty dollars, except for:
- 13 a. A violation of section 39-10-26, 39-10-26.2, 39-10-41, 39-10-42, 39-10-46, or 39-10-46.1, a fee of fifty dollars.
- b. A violation of section 39-10-05 involving failure to yield to a pedestrian or
 subsection 1 of section 39-10-28, a fee of fifty dollars.
- 17 c. A violation of section 39-21-41.2, a fee of twenty-five dollars.
- d. A violation of subsection 1 of section 39-12-02 or section 39-08-23, a fee of one
 hundred dollars.
- e. A violation of subdivision d of subsection 1 of section 39-12-04, a fee of one hundred dollars.
- f. A violation of subsection 1 of section 39-04-37 by an individual by becoming a resident of this state, a fee of one hundred dollars.

For a violation of a school zone speed limit under subdivision b of subsection 1 of 21 section 39-09-02, or, notwithstanding subsection 2 of section 40-05-06 or section 22 40-05.1-06, of an ordinance in a city or home rule city for a violation of a speed limit 23 dependent upon being on or near a school, fees for a noncriminal disposition are 24 fortyeighty dollars for one through ten miles per hour over the posted speed; and 25 fortyeighty dollars, plus one dollartwo dollars for each additional mile per hour over ten 26 miles per hour over the limit unless a greater fee would be applicable under this 27 section. 28 For a violation of a highway construction zone speed limit under subsection 2 of 13.12. 29 section 39-09-02, a fee of eighty dollars for one through ten miles per hour over the 30 posted speed; and eighty dollars plus two dollars for each mile per hour over ten miles

per hour over the limit, unless a greater fee would be applicable under this section.

1	The fee in this subsection does not apply to a highway construction zone unless		
2	individuals engaged in construction are present at the time and place of the violation		
3	and the posted speed limit sign states "Minimum Fee \$80".		
4	SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Subsection 2 of section 40-05-06 of the North Dakota Century		
5	Code is amended and reenacted as follows:		
6	2. <u>a.</u> For <u>Except as otherwise provided under subdivision b, for every violation of a city</u>		
7	ordinance regulatingthat regulates the operation or equipment of a motor-		
8	vehiclesvehicle or regulatingwhich regulates traffic, except those ordinances		
9	listed in section 39-06.1-05, a fee may be established, by ordinance, which may		
0	not exceed the limits, for equivalent categories of violations, set forth in section		
11	39-06.1-06.		
2	b. A home rule city may establish, by ordinance, a fee for the violation of a		
3	city ordinance that regulates the operation or equipment of a motor vehicle or		
4	which regulates traffic, except those ordinances listed in section 39-06.1-05, if the		
5	fee is for driving in excess of speed limitations and the fee does not exceed two		
6	times the limits in section 39-06.1-06 or if the fee is for a moving violation other		
7	than driving in excess of speed limitations and does not exceed three times the		
8	limits in section 39-06.1-06.
