3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsection 9 of section 15.1-06-04 of the North Dakota

5 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

11			<u>num</u>	nber of hours during which students are required to be in attendance for the
12			purp	pose of receiving curricular instruction.
13			<u>(1)</u>	For kindergarten students, the number of required hours is five and
14				<u>one-half;</u>
15			<u>(2)</u>	For elementary students, the number of required hours through June 30,
16				2014, is five and one-half and thereafter six and one-half; and
17			<u>(3)</u>	For high school students, the number of required hours through June 30,
18				2014, is six and thereafter the greater of:
19				(a) Seven; or
20				(b) One hour more than the duration of the district's 2013-14 high school
21				instructional day.
22		<u>b.</u>	<u>A so</u>	chool district may increase the minimum number of hours required under this
