- A BILL for an Act to reimburse school districts and nonpublic schools for expenses incurred in
- 2 providing cardiopulmonary resuscitation training to students; and to provide an appropriation.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** There is appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$450,000, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, to the superintendent of public instruction for the purpose of reimbursing school districts and nonpublic schools for costs incurred in providing cardiopulmonary resuscitation training to students, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2013, and ending June 30, 2015.
 - 1. In order to be eligible for a reimbursement under this section, aEach school district shall set aside one high school class period in a required course of the district's choosing, for the purpose of providing instruction in cardiopulmonary resuscitation to as many students as possible. Each nonpublic school shall set aside one high school class period in a required course of the school's choosing, for the purpose of providing instruction in cardiopulmonary resuscitation to as many students as possible. The training must:
 - a. Conform to the most recent national evidence-based American heart association guidelines for cardiopulmonary resuscitation and emergency cardiovascular care;
 - Be conducted according to guidelines established by the American heart association, the American red cross, or some other nationally recognized nonprofit organization;
 - c. Include the practice of chest compressions; and
- Include instruction in the use of an automated external defibrillator.

1 Upon completion of the training, theeach school district and nonpublic school 2 may submit to the superintendent of public instruction documentation verifying 3 the training and any expenses incurred by the district in providing the training. 4 For purposes of this section, "reimbursable expenses" include costs for b. 5 instructors, training staff as instructors, instructional materials, and training 6 manikins. 7 A school district's reimbursement may not exceed the equivalent of \$30 multiplied 8 by the number of district students undergoing the training. A nonpublic school's 9 reimbursement may not exceed the equivalent of \$30 multiplied by the number of the school's students undergoing the training. 10 11 3. A school district School districts and nonpublic schools may combine with other school 12 districts and nonpublic schools to provide the training or direct that a regional 13 education association provide or facilitate the training. 14 The superintendent of public instruction shall provide the reimbursements to school 15 districts and nonpublic schools in accordance with the order in which completed 16 requests are received.
